Car users:

Car users: We understand that for some people walking to school is not possible due to distance/work commitments. Please consider these ³ options:

Park and Stride: Park away from Kirkstead Road and its immediate area and walk the rest of the way to school. This would ease congestion around the school gates and make the area safer for our children.

Car Share: Why not team up with others in your area and share the journey to school? Saving both time and money!
