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Dear Parents

Reception Parent Evenings

Parking

PSHE

Safeguarding

If you are late to drop off or pick up your children, please come to the school office rather than attempting to access school another way. Everyone entering school must be signed in.

Many children have received wonderful watches for Christmas. We are very pleased that children are learning to tell the time. Please can parents ensure that the devices that children have in school do not have a camera as these are not allowed on the school site for safeguarding purposes.

Safer Internet Day

We are also joining with Hursthead Junior School to host an evening to give advice to parents on keeping children safe online. This will be delivered by Tanya Cross, Schools Health & Wellbeing Adviser for Stockport authority. The evening will take place on Thursday 2 March at 6pm at the Junior School. A crèche will be available if parents are unable to find childcare in order to attend the

event. Both Mrs Kendrick and I strongly advise parents and carers to attend this event, which should not last for more than an hour.

Sickness

We currently have a sickness bug in all year groups. Please remember that children with diarrhoea or vomiting should not be in school until they have not been sick or had diarrhoea for at least 2 days (48 hours).

If your child is taking antibiotics or any other medication, including Calpol, please let the class teacher know, even if we are not administrating medicine in school. This is so staff are aware that children may be feeling under the weather, and are able to respond to children's needs appropriately.
