#### Learning Characters



Evidence suggests the use of 'metacognitive strategies' - which get pupils to think about their own learning - can have a positive impact on children's progress. At school we have adopted learning characters which we use to encourage children to become self-regulated learners who can motivate themselves to engage in and improve their learning. I have attached our learning characters to this newsletter and would encourage parents to talk about these at home as regularly as you can.

# Eat Them to Defeat Them

'Eat Them to Defeat Them' is a campaign created by Veg Power and ITV to encourage children to eat more vegetables. This year the campaign starts during half term and I have attached the information for parents to this newsletter.
