Come and enjoy traditional fair games such as hook a duck, beat the goalie, spin the wheel and beat the buzz; see if you can beat the odds on the ever-popular sweetie tombola; browse the pre-loved uniform and book stalls; get a (temporary) tattoo or two; and have a go on the bouncy castle. Peckish and parched? Why not grab a bite to eat, visit the fully licensed bar and finish up at the cake stall.

This amazing family day out has always been a success because of the famous Hursthead community spirit with everyone coming together to help out. The children are really proud and excited when they see one (or more!) family members on a stall. Class reps will soon be asking for volunteers for their class stall. A big thank you to those of you who have stepped forward to help already.

On the day itself the fair is a **CASH ONLY EVENT** however, you can purchase Play Passes in advance. They will come home in book bags by Friday 17^{th} May. Most games and children's activities at the fair will cost £1 and an early bird Play Pass with 12 plays is just £10 (saving £2!).
