The Parent/Staff Association (PSA) would like to extend a very warm welcome to all the parents and carers of children who are starting in Reception this September. Starting school is a big milestone for our children, and they, and you, have joined a wonderful, friendly school community. The PSA is part of that community: every parent, carer and staff member is automatically a member of the PSA. Which means that everyone has a voice.

We appreciate there is a lot of information to take in at this time, with that in mind, below are some bullet points that will hopefully give you an understanding of what the PSA is and what it does to help entertain and support your children and their education.

- The PSA is run on a 100% volunteer basis, with a committee of parents who organise fundraising and social events throughout the school year.
- Funds raised have previously been used to pay for subsidising school trips for each year group, educational visitors to school and maintaining the modern foreign language provision.
- The committee, supported by the Headteacher in the role of President, consists of Chair, Vice-Chair, Treasurer and Secretary with additional general committee members. Class reps, nominated to represent each individual class also assist the committee.
- We completely understand that you might not be at school every day or be able to attend meetings but every little helps and specific requests will appear throughout the year. If you can spare a little time, many hands make light work. Sometimes we need helpers in school to run the discos, mother's/father's day events or helping from home by wrapping up secret santa gifts for the Christmas fair.
